

The 'so what'

Variation in number of people having a health check (% difference from Q1-Q2 19/20 compared to Q1-Q2 of the previous 4 years; 15/16-18/19)



From Q1 2015/16 to Q2 2019/20

34,316 Invited (45% of eligible)

17,158 Completed (50.2% uptake)

From most deprived wards (IMD) Uptake increases with deprivation.

2018/19 Data shows us that...



11,000 invited (up by 7,000 from 2017)



5882 completed (up by 2,400 from 2017)




1,000 identified as a high CVD risk

75 newly diagnosed Type 2 Diabetes






